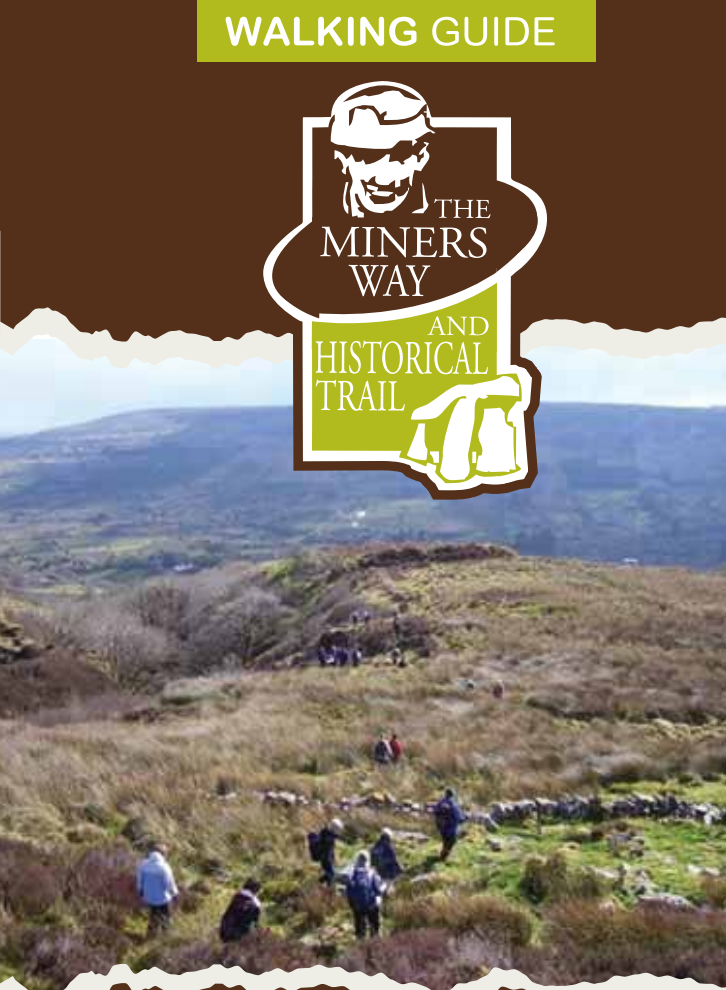


Arigna Mining Experience, an unique underground tour in what was Ireland's last working coal mine. All tours guided by ex-miners, open 7 days, located adjacent

The Bricklieve Mountains & Carrowkeel with its passage tombs in Ireland, believed to have been constructed between 3000 and 2000 BC.

The Miners Way is a series of way-marked routes that form a network through Counties Roscommon, Sligo & Leitrim. The Miners Way follows many of the paths used by miners going to work in the Arigna Mines.

The Miners Way links with the **Historical Trail** which traverses the Curlew, Bricklieve & Arigna Mountains, passing many features of interest, including Carrowkeel megalithic tombs, Labby rock & wind farms. The two routes total over 118 kms in length, a range of walks to suit all levels of walkers. The route passes areas that are renowned for Sequoia Trees.
